The Moriah House Family Shelter accepts families and female veterans who are homeless or living in substandard conditions. **Moriah House provides safe, temporary shelter and a full range of transitional services** for families challenged by hardship.



208 People Served

Including 75 families, 89 adults, 119 children, and 23 female veterans



31,578 Meals Served

Shelter residences receive three meals a day in the Shelter's private dining room



10,526 Nights of Lodging

The average length of stay was 49 days, and 75% of families exited to positive housing outcomes

Family Shelter Services include:

- Private rooms & beds
- Personalized case management
- Housing navigation
- Trauma-informed family support
- Tenancy education, financial literacy, & life skills coaching

Moriah House families are facing significant economic adversity and challenges like domestic abuse, chemical dependency, physical & mental illness, and lack of employment. All residents meet Ohio's guidelines for extremely low or low income levels with over 90% in the extremely-low income category.
